COLLEGE IS HARD. GETTING IN DOESN'T HAVE TO BE.

Overview:

In partnership with your high school's guidance department, Solution Prep's Summer Admissions Program is an eight-week course for rising seniors aimed at helping them complete the bulk of their college application project by the end of the summer. It is part writing program, part admissions coaching, and part project management. By the end, students should have most or all of their college essays completed and most or all of their applications ready to be submitted.

Class Size and Materials:

For each cohort, one teacher can teach the minimum class size of 10 students, up to the maximum of 20 students. If more than 20 students enroll, an additional teacher will be added and students will be split into a maximum of two cohorts, up to 40 students in total. Students each need access to a computer and high-speed internet in class and to complete independent work assigned between classes. Solution Prep will supply each student with their own **Admissions Workbook**, which can be co-branded with the school's logo if desired.

Program Cost and Scholarships:

The per-student tuition is \$495 for fewer than 20 students. For 21-40 students, tuition will be **reduced to** \$395 per student. A school may, at its discretion, subsidize part of this tuition, but it is important the course to still have value to students and parents to encourage consistent attendance and participation. Solution Prep would prefer that the portion of tuition passed on to families not be less than \$195 for the course after any school contribution, but leave the decision to the school. Solution Prep will host the online registration.

There will be two (2) available **full scholarships** and two (2) available **50% scholarships** available per cohort for your guidance department to coordinate with students and parents it has determined have both demonstrated need and the interest and motivation to fully utilize the opportunity of this course.

Location and Scheduling:

This weekly summer program can be hosted in-person, online, or hybrid, through July and August. Should the pandemic persist at that time, there must be adequate space for social distancing, and students and teachers must wear masks in accordance with CDC guidelines. Solution Prep has available up to two teachers (depending on enrollment as described above) on your school's choice of morning, afternoon, and evening options. Contact us for current availability. Availability may change until a day/time is confirmed as Solution Prep is actively scheduling this program at schools.
